Dear IB Parents and Students,

October is the registration month for International Baccalaureate Examinations that will be given in May 2017. It is important that parents and students carefully consider the options available for testing.

In the first year of the IB Program (11<sup>th</sup> grade), students are not allowed to take more than two examinations. This applies both for the Diploma as well as the Certificate candidate.

Parents and students are reminded that each college and university may differ on how much credit they will award for IB examinations. For example, most schools will award college credit for Higher Level exams with a score of 5 or above. The policy for awarding credit for Standard Level examinations will vary from university to university. Each candidate must consider their obligation and commitment to the successful completion of their chosen course of study.

#### Test Fee Program 2016-2017

For 2016-2017, as a result of funding provided by the Oregon State Legislature and the US Department of Education (USDOE), low income students who show proof that they receive Free and/or Reduced funding for meals, will pay nothing for their IB exams. All other Oregon public school students taking IB exams will have their Subject Fees reduced.

### **Payment for exams is due on or before Wednesday November 2, 2016**

Students are assessed both a registration and subject fee for the IB examinations. Below is the fee schedule for the May 2017 examinations.

##### **A. Registration Fees**

-per Anticipated (A) candidate (Grade 11 student contemplating Full IB and enrolled in all IB courses in Grade 11)	\$169.00
-per Diploma (D) candidate (Grade 12 student who took one or two exams the previous year)	\$00.00

-per Diploma (D) candidate (Grade 12 Full Diploma student taking all 6 subject exams their 12 grade year	\$169.00
-per Certificate (C) candidate (Grade 11 or 12 partial IB student taking one or more examinations)	\$169.00

-Fee for each subject that a candidate is registered for	\$86.00

1. Total for Anticipated Candidate taking one exam (Grade 11 contemplating the full IB Diploma taking one examination)

-Registration Fees	\$169.00
-Subject Fee (\$86.00 x 1 exam)	\$86.00

2. Total for Certificate Candidate taking 3 exams (Grade 12)

-Registration Fees	\$169.00
-Subject Fee (\$86.00 x 3 exams)	\$258.00

**Non-Refundable Total**      **\$427.00**

3. Total for Diploma Candidate (Grade 12 taking five examinations and tested the previous year in one subject as an Anticipated candidate)

-Registration Fee	\$00.00
-Subject Fee (\$86.00 x 5 exams)	\$430.00

**Non-Refundable Total**      **\$430.00**

4. Total for Diploma Candidate taking 6 exams in Grade 12

-Registration Fee	\$169.00
-Subject Fee (\$86.00 x 6 exams)	\$516.00

**Non-Refundable Total**      **\$685.00**
